On June 2, 2016 we visited the [Governor's Mansion](#). There were about 30 of us who attended. They do not allow taking pictures inside.

The Mansion is open during June, July, and August from 1:00pm - 4:00pm every Thursday afternoon, by appointment only 801.538.1005, address 603 East South temple, Salt Lake City, Utah. Parking is available east of the Mansion behind the Utah Arts Council building, accessible from H Street.

The interior has been restored to nearly as possible its condition when the Kearns family built it in the late 1800s with the new, highly expressive styles that marked the first decade of the twentieth century. It is fun to see it and learn the stories that the building has experienced over the years. We gathered at the parking area next to the Utah Arts Council building, were greeted by a Utah State Trooper (they are handling security for the Mansion), divided into two manageable groups sizes, then toured the Mansion, ground floor only. The sitting governor still occupies the building on the second level, and the third level is a ballroom.
