### Next Meeting



Her topic is **"Lift Up Your Heart! Lift Up Your Voice! The evolution of singing among the early saints."**

She is an active piano teacher of more than 40 years, has an extensive education and background in music having graduated from Brigham Young University with an Associate Degree in Piano Technology, a BA in Piano Pedagogy, and a MA in Piano Pedagogy and Performance from the New England Conservatory and Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey. She has sung with the BYU a Capella Choir, Oregon Repertory Singers, Texas Bach Choir, and 10 years with the Mormon Tabernacle Choir.

Sister Olsen currently serves in the Salt Lake Ensign Stake Relief Society and as director of the Canyon Road Ward Choir. Additionally she is finishing a 6-year term as the President of the [Utah Music Teachers Association](#), with a membership of over 600, which has given her an opportunity to travel throughout Utah to speak to groups of piano teachers.
