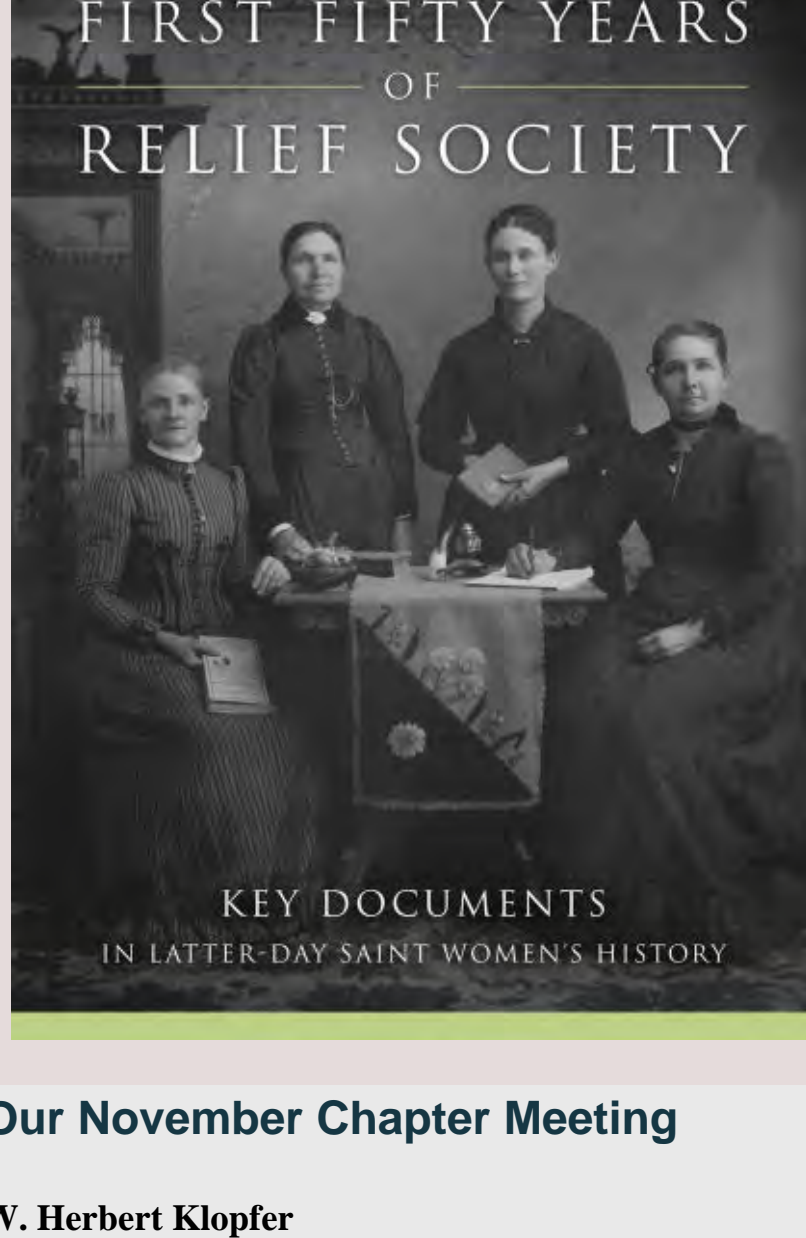

We had brother Klopfer as our guest, a second appearance after he had spoken to us in November 2014. Again we were acquainted with some miracles in the life of his family, especially about his father, who was president of the East German Mission, and had to serve in the German army.

Brother Klopfer told about his family's exit from Germany during the Third Reich, and about the experience of his father wanting to go to Sacramento Meeting while stationed in Denmark. He gave us a copy of that account, and have attached it to this email. 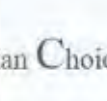

WHAT TO WEAR???

The Pioneers crossed the plains in wagons and handcarts from 1847-1869, so we are looking for clothing they would have made or mail-ordered shortly after arriving in the Utah Territory. Fashions had a distinct look in 1850 that only slightly changed into the Civil War Era from 1861-1865. The Victorian Era was during Queen Victoria's reign from 1837-1901. Any of these fashions would be appropriate for the pioneering times at Brigham's Christmas Ball.
